We are beginning an important Fall for us here at First Baptist Church Orangeburg. Not only will we elect our <u>His Hands Strategic Planning Team</u>, we have set a fall Missions emphasis to completely fund the Haiti Orphanage we have been working with since 2011. Judy Hangels-King started the Foyer Divin Orphanage in 2004 to help care for the large population of orphans and abandoned children in Port-au-Prince. A group from Catch the Vision comprised largely of members of FBCO visited the Orphanage in 2011. We fell in love with the children! Catch the Vision and FBCO, through generous donor support, has helped supply food, shoes, and funding for the children's school expenses as resources have been available. It is the Fall Missions Goal of FBCO to fund each child who is currently housed at the orphanage. By sponsoring a child in the orphanage for **\$250 per year** you will ensure that they have the adequate nutrition and basic necessities we take for granted that are needed to grow and learn. Just a few dollars a month can change a child's life in Haiti. More than half of the children have already been sponsored, but we have <u>17 still in need of support</u>. Jerry French, CTVI's Executive Director, will be traveling to Haiti in November to check on the children and monitor the Orphanage.

It's hard to imagine we finished our 100 days of prayer over two months ago. However, prayer leads to action. As a church we now begin the next phase in our process. The 100 days of prayer was a way for us to move beyond our own preconceived notions and open ourselves up to ways in which God might be calling us as a church to move forward. To continue in this process you will be asked to nominate up to 15 people to serve on the **His Hands Strategic Planning Team**. This team will have <u>3 sub-teams</u> with <u>5 people on each sub-team</u>. A brief description of these teams can be found below. The 3 sub-teams will specifically look at the **Institutional**, **Spiritual**, and **Missional** areas of our church as we seek to strengthen the future of FBCO for the next 15-20 years. During the month of October you will have an opportunity to nominate members to serve on the **His Hands Strategic Planning Team**.

The **Institutional Sub-Team** will examine the day-to-day functioning of the church. The purpose of this sub-team will be to look for ways in which FBCO can continue to be a strong, vibrant institution in the future. As we see church attendance and church budgets shrink across the country regardless of denomination, this is a way for us to be proactive rather than reactive in times of change.

The **Spiritual Sub-Team** will examine the worship and discipleship programs of the church. This sub-team will look for ways to strengthen these programs so we can continue to cultivate disciples for Jesus Christ in Orangeburg, SC, and offer worship that glorifies God. This is a way for us to think creatively about how to best minister to and with the people of this community and how to offer authentic worship experiences that are about God rather than our own personal preferences.

The <u>Missional Sub-Team</u> will examine the missions of the church. This sub-team will look for ways to strengthen an already strong part of our church specifically by looking for ways to give people a hand up rather than a hand out. This is a way for us to think about methods that change lives by helping people for the long term rather than short term, temporary fixes.

Please continue to pray for our His Hands Team. Pray for their wisdom and discernment as with God leading us we seek to strengthen an already strong church for the future. Please also pray about choosing to adopt a single Haiti Orphan and become the tangible presence of Jesus Christ to them through your gift and adoption.
