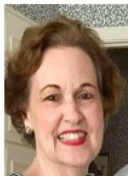

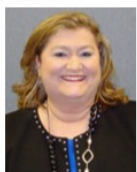

Children's Ministry News...

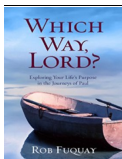
