Children's Ministry News

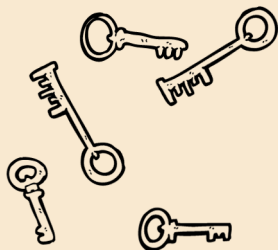

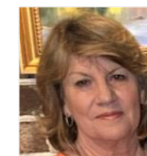
